- **A.** The resource can take any of the following forms:

 - (xi) A talking book
 - (xii) An animated cartoon with a message
 - (xiii) A resource for the Interactive Whiteboard
 - (xiv) An interactive reference tool
 - (xv) Some other format not covered by the above list.
- B. The resource must include
 - (i) Animation
 - (ii) Interactivity (At least one button)
 - (iii) Sound
- **C**. The content must be appropriate to young children and be designed to support learning in at least one curricular area of the Primary School Curriculum or in Religious Education.
- D. Marks will be awarded for
 - (i) Appropriateness of Content
 - (ii) Educational Potential
 - (iii) Appearance / Attractiveness to children
 - (iv) Originality / Imagination / Creativity
 - (v) Technical Quality
 - (vi) Smoothness of operation
